MOTOR VEHICLES. Provides that the Office of Motor Vehicles shall create a prestige license plate for telecommunicators. (8/1/24)

AN ACT

2	To enact R.S. 47:463.230, relative to motor vehicle special prestige license plates; to provide
3	for the establishment of the "Telecommunicator" special prestige license plate; to
4	provide for creation, issuance, design, fees, distribution, and rule promulgation
5	applicable to such license plates; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 47:463.230 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§463.230. Special prestige license plate; "Telecommunicator"
9	A.(1) The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
10	shall establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the
11	"Telecommunicator" plate, provided there is a minimum of one thousand
12	applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
13	pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
14	(2) The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor
15	vehicles, shall create the special prestige license plate when the applicable
16	statutory provisions are met and the department's electronic vehicle and title
17	registration system is updated to accommodate the creation of new plates.

1	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the chairpersons of the
2	Louisiana Care and Compassion Committee of the Louisiana Association of
3	Public Safety Communications Officials to select the color and design of the
4	plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall
5	include the words "Telecommunicator".
6	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to
7	any Telecommunicator in good standing with a law enforcement, EMS, fire, or
8	a 9-1-1 agency the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
9	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five
10	dollars that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section.
11	This fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed
12	by Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of
13	three dollars and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to
14	offset a portion of administrative costs.
15	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and
16	forwarded to the Louisiana Care and Compassion Committee of the Louisiana
17	Association of Public Safety Communications Officials.
18	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
19	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the "Telecommunicator" special prestige license plate.

SB 375 Original

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to issue the special prestige license plates, provided there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants for the plate.

2024 Regular Session

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the office of motor vehicles will create the plate when OMV's electronic vehicle and title registration system is updated.

Proposed law provides the design of the plate shall include the words "Telecommunicator".

<u>Proposed law</u> directs the department to collect an annual royalty fee and forward certain percentages to the Louisiana Care and Compassion Committee of the Louisiana Association
