30 "§463.234. Special prestige license plate; "Icitte on parle français"

1           A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 2 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Icitte on  
 3 parle français" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants  
 4 for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,  
 5 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

6           B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Télé-Louisiane, to select the  
 7 color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3).  
 8 The design shall include the words "Icitte on parle français".

9           C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 10 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

11           D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 12 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 13 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 14 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 15 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 16 administrative costs.

17           E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 18 to Télé-Louisiane. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used to assist  
 19 the Télé-Louisiane French programming LPB.

20           F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 21 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

22  
 23 §463.235. Special prestige license plate; "Bienvenue en Louisiane"

24           A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 25 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the  
 26 "Bienvenue en Louisiane " plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand  
 27 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,  
 28 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

29           B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane,  
 30 to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.  
 31 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bienvenue en Louisiane".

32           C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 33 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

34           D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 35 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 36 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 37 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 38 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 39 administrative costs.

40           E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 41 to L'Assemblée de la Louisiane. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be  
 42 used to assist L'Assemblée de la Louisiane fund initiative to promote French in  
 43 Louisiana and expand French immersion in schools .

44           F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 45 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

46  
 47 §463.236. Special prestige license plate; "Lâche Pas"

48           A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 49 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Lâche  
 50 Pas" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such  
 51 plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,  
 52 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

53           B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane,  
 54 to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.  
 55 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Lache Pas".

56           C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 57 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

58           D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 59 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty

1 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 2 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 3 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 4 administrative costs.

5 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 6 to L'Assemblée de Louisiane . The monies received from the royalty fees shall be  
 7 used to assist Lâche Pas Vermilion cultural heritage program .

8 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 9 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

10 §463.237. Special prestige license plate; "Bayou Indian"

11 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 12 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Bayou  
 13 Indian" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such  
 14 plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,  
 15 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

16 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to  
 17 select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.  
 18 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bayou Indian".

19 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 20 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

21 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 22 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 23 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 24 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 25 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 26 administrative costs.

27 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 28 to Ecole Pointe-au-Chien. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used  
 29 to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.

30 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 31 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

32 §463.238. Special prestige license plate; "Bayou Cajun"

33 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 34 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Bayou  
 35 Cajun" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such  
 36 plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,  
 37 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

38 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to  
 39 select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.  
 40 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bayou Cajun".

41 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 42 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

43 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 44 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 45 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 46 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 47 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 48 administrative costs.

49 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 50 to Ecole Pointe-au-Chien . The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used  
 51 to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.

52 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 53 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

54 §463.239. Special prestige license plate; "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier"

55 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall

1 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Je chasse  
 2 au Grand Chenier" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand  
 3 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,  
 4 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

5 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane  
 6 in consultation with local residents of Cameron Parish, to select the color and design  
 7 of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall  
 8 include the words "Je chasse au Grand Chenier".

9 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 10 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

11 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 12 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 13 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 14 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 15 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 16 administrative costs.

17 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 18 to L'Assemblée de Louisiane. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be  
 19 used to assist the creation of a French immersion program in Cameron Parish.

20 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 21 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

22 §463.240. Special prestige license plate; "United States Submarine Veterans"

23 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 24 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "United  
 25 States Submarine Veterans" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand  
 26 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,  
 27 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

28 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the United States Submarine  
 29 Veterans Charitable Foundation, Inc., to select the color and design of the plate,  
 30 provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the  
 31 words "United States Submarine Veterans".

32 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 33 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

34 D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 35 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 36 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 37 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 38 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 39 administrative costs.

40 E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 41 to the treasurer of the United States Submarine Veterans Charitable Foundation, Inc.  
 42 The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used to provide scholarships for  
 43 children.

44 F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 45 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

46 §463.241. Special prestige license plate; "Leesville High School Alumni"

47 A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 48 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as "Leesville  
 49 High School " plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for  
 50 such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,  
 51 recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

52 B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Alumni Association  
 53 Executive Board, to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in  
 54 compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Leesville  
 55 High School Alumni".

56 C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 57 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

1           D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 2 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 3 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 4 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 5 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 6 administrative costs.

7           E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 8 to Leesville High School Alumni Association. The monies received from the royalty  
 9 fees shall be used to provide scholarships.

10          F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 11 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

12 §463.242. Special prestige license plate; "Humane Society of Louisiana"

13          A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall  
 14 establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as "Humane  
 15 Society of Louisiana" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand  
 16 applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,  
 17 pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

18          B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Humane Society of  
 19 Louisiana, to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance  
 20 with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Humane Society of  
 21 Louisiana".

22          C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any  
 23 citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

24          D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars  
 25 that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty  
 26 fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article  
 27 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars  
 28 and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of  
 29 administrative costs.

30          E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded  
 31 to the treasurer of the Humane Society of Louisiana. The monies received from the  
 32 royalty fees shall be used to fund spay and neuter programs to help with current  
 33 overpopulation of animals.

34          F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are  
 35 necessary to implement the provisions of this Section."
