MTR VEHICLE/LICEN PLATES: Creates specialty license plates

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 463.230 through 463.242, relative to motor vehicle special prestige license
3	plates; to provide for the establishment of the "3' for Cyclists", the "Support our
4	Wildlife Rehabilitators", "St. Thomas Aquinas", and "Evangel Christian Academy",
5	"Icitte on parle français", "Bienvenue en Louisiane", "Lâche Pas", "Bayou Indian",
6	"Bayou Cajun", "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier", "United States Submarine Veterans",
7	"Leesville High School Alumni", and "Humane Society of Louisiana" specialty
8	license plates; to provide for the creation, issuance, design, fees, implementation,
9	distribution, and rule promulgation applicable to such license plates; and to provide
10	for related matters.
11	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
12	Section 1. R.S. 47:463.230 through 463.242 are hereby enacted to read as follows:
13	§463.230. Special prestige license plate; "3' for Cyclists"
14	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
15	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "3' for
16	Cyclists" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such
17	plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
18	recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
19	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Metro Bicycle Coalition
20	of New Orleans, otherwise known as Bike Easy, to select the color and design of the

1	plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include
2	the words "3' for Cyclists".
3	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
4	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
5	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
6	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
7	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
8	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
9	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
10	administrative costs.
11	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
12	to the Metro Bicycle Coalition of New Orleans. The monies received from the
13	royalty fees shall be used to assist the Metro Bicycle Coalition of New Orleans.
14	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
15	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
16	§463.231. Special prestige license plate; "Support Our Wildlife Rehabilitators"
17	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
18	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Support
19	Our Wildlife Rehabilitators" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
20	applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
21	pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
22	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Wildlife Rehabilitators
23	Support Council, otherwise known as the council, to select the color and design of
24	the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall
25	include the words "Support Our Wildlife Rehabilitators" and an image or logo of a
26	wild animal.
27	
	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any

1	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
2	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
3	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
4	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
5	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
6	administrative costs.
7	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
8	to the Council. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used to assist
9	with the costs of wildlife rehabilitation.
10	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
11	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
12	§463.232. Special prestige license plate; "St. Thomas Aquinas"
13	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
14	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "St.
15	Thomas Aquinas" plate provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants
16	for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
17	recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
18	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the St. Thomas Aquinas
19	Regional Catholic High School, to select the color and design of the plate, provided
20	it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "St.
21	Thomas Aquinas".
22	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
23	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
24	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
25	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
26	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
27	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
28	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
29	administrative costs.

1	\underline{E} . The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
2	to the St. Thomas Aquinas Regional Catholic High School. The monies received
3	from the royalty fees shall be used to assist the administration of the school.
4	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
5	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
6	§463.233. Special prestige license plate; "Evangel Christian Academy"
7	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
8	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Evangel
9	Christian Academy" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
10	applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
11	pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
12	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Evangel Christian Academy
13	administration, to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in
14	compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Evangel
15	Christian Academy".
16	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
17	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
18	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
19	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
20	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
21	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
22	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
23	administrative costs.
24	\underline{E} . The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
25	to the Evangel Christian Academy's administration. The monies received from the
26	royalty fees shall be used to assist the school.
27	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
28	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.

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1	§463.234. Special prestige license plate; "Icitte on parle français"
2	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
3	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Icitte on
4	parle français" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants
5	for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
6	recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
7	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Télé-Louisiane, to select the
8	color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3).
9	The design shall include the words "Icitte on parle français".
10	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
11	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
12	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
13	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
14	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
15	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
16	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
17	administrative costs.
18	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded

24	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
25	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the
26	"Bienvenue en Louisiane " plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
27	applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
28	pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.

1	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane,
2	to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
3	47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bienvenue en Louisiane".
4	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
5	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
6	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
7	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
8	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
9	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
10	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of

19	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
20	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Lâche
21	Pas" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such
22	plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
23	recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
24	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane,
25	to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
26	47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Lache Pas".
27	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
28	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

1	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
2	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
3	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
4	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
5	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
6	administrative costs.
7	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
8	to L'Assemblée de Louisiane. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be
9	used to assist Lâche Pas Vermilion cultural heritage program.
10	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
11	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
12	§463.237. Special prestige license plate; "Bayou Indian"
13	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
14	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Bayou
15	Indian" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such
16	plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
17	recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
18	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to
19	select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
20	47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bayou Indian".
21	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
22	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
23	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
24	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
25	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
26	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
27	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
28	administrative costs.

1	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
2	to Ecole Pointe-au-Chien. The monies received from the royalty fees shall be used
3	to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.
4	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
5	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
6	§463.238. Special prestige license plate; "Bayou Cajun"
7	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
8	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Bayou
9	Cajun" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand applicants for such
10	plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks,
11	recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
12	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au Chien, to
13	select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S.
14	47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Bayou Cajun".
15	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
16	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
17	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
18	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
19	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article

2	applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
3	pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
4	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane
5	in consultation with local residents of Cameron Parish, to select the color and design
6	of the plate, provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall
7	include the words "Je chasse au Grand Chenier".
8	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
9	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
10	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
11	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
12	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
13	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
14	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of

27	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the United States Submarine
28	Veterans Charitable Foundation, Inc., to select the color and design of the plate,

1	provided it is in compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the
2	words "United States Submarine Veterans".
3	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
4	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
5	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
6	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
7	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article

22	recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
23	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Alumni Association
24	Executive Board, to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in
25	compliance with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Leesville
26	High School Alumni".
27	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
28	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

1	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
2	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
3	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
4	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
5	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
6	administrative costs.
7	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
8	to Leesville High School Alumni Association. The monies received from the royalty
9	fees shall be used to provide scholarships.

12	§463.242. Special prestige license plate; "Humane Society of Louisiana"
13	A. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall
14	establish a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as "Humane
15	Society of Louisiana" plate, provided that there is a minimum of one thousand
16	applicants for such plate. The plate shall be restricted to use on passenger cars,
17	pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans.
18	B. The secretary shall work in conjunction with the Humane Society of
19	Louisiana, to select the color and design of the plate, provided it is in compliance
20	with R.S. 47:463(A)(3). The design shall include the words "Humane Society of
21	Louisiana".
22	C. The special prestige license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any
23	citizen of Louisiana in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.
24	D. The department shall collect an annual royalty fee of twenty-five dollars
25	that shall be disbursed in accordance with Subsection E of this Section. This royalty
26	fee shall be in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed by Article
27	VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Louisiana, and a handling fee of three dollars
28	and fifty cents for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of
29	administrative costs.

1	E. The annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded
2	to the treasurer of the Humane Society of Louisiana. The monies received from the
3	royalty fees shall be used to fund spay and neuter programs to help with current
4	overpopulation of animals.
5	F. The secretary shall promulgate and adopt rules and regulations as are
6	necessary to implement the provisions of this Section.
7	Section 2. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor
8	vehicles, is hereby directed to create these special prestige license plates when the applicable
9	statutory provisions are met and its system is updated to accommodate the creation of new
10	plates.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from the "St. Thomas Aquinas" specialty license plate be solely used to assist the administration.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from the "Evangel Christian Academy" plate be used solely to assist the school.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from the "Icitte on parle français" specialty license plate be used solely to assist Télé-Louisiane French programming LPB.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Bienvenue en Louisiane" be used to assist L'Assemblée de la Louisiane fund initiative to promote French in Louisiana and expand French immersion in schools.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Lâche Pas" be used to assist Lâche Pas Vermilion cultural heritage program.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Bayou Indian" be used to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming. <u>Proposed law</u> requires monies from "Bayou Cajun" be used to assist Ecole Pointe-au-Chien French immersion programming.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to select the color and design of the "Bayou Indian" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Bayou Indian".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary work in conjunction with Ecole Pointe-au-Chien, to select the color and design of the "Bayou Cajun" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Bayou Cajun".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with L'Assemblée de Louisiane in consultation with local residents of Cameron Parish, to select the color and design of the "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with the United States Submarine Veterans Charitable Foundation, Inc., to select the color and design of the United States Submarine Veterans" plate. Further requires the design to include the words "United States Submarine Veterans".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with the Alumni Association Executive Board, to select the color and design of the "Leesville High School Alumni" plate. Further requires the design include the words "Leesville High School Alumni".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to work in conjunction with the Humane Society of Louisiana, to select the color and design of the "Humane Society of Louisiana" plate. Further requires the design include the words "Humane Society of Louisiana".

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that the license plates be issued, upon application, to any citizen of La. in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the department to collect an annual royalty fee of \$25 in addition to the standard motor vehicle license tax and a \$3.50 handling fee for each plate to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to promulgate and adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions provided in <u>proposed law</u>.

Directs the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to create the "Share the Road", "Support Our Wildlife Rehabilitators", "St. Thomas Aquinas", "Evangel Christian Academy", "Icitte on parle français", Bienvenue en Louisiane", "Lâche Pas", "Bayou Indian", "Bayou Cajun", "Je Chasse au Grand Chenier", "United States Submarine Veterans", "Leesville High School Alumni", and "Humane Society of Louisiana" speciality license plates when the applicable statutory provisions are met and its system is updated to accommodate the creation of new plates.
