ELECTION CODE. Defines "deep fake" in the Election Code. (8/1/24)

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 18:2(2) through (15) and to enact R.S. 18:2(16), relative to
3	definitions; to define the term "deep fake"; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 18:2(2) through (15) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
6	18:2(16) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§2. Definitions
8	As used in this Code, the following words and terms shall have the meanings
9	hereinafter ascribed to each, unless the context clearly indicates another meaning:
10	* * *
11	(2)"Deep fake" means synthetic media created with the intent to mislead
12	or deceive others which depicts a candidate via video, image, or sound recording
13	without his consent, except for any media which conspicuously displays a notice
14	clearly identifying that the media is computer generated or not a genuine
15	depiction of a person or events.
16	(2)(3) "Federal election" means a general, special, primary, or runoff election
17	for federal office; a convention or caucus of a political party which has authority to

1	nominate a candidate for federal office; a primary election held for the selection of
2	delegates to a national nominating convention of a political party; and a primary
3	election held for the expression of a preference for the nomination of individuals for
4	election to the office of president.
5	(3)(4) "Federal office" means the office of president or vice president of the
6	United States or of senator or representative in the United States Congress.
7	(4)(5) "Immediate family" means the individual's children, the spouses of his
8	children, his brothers and their spouses, his sisters and their spouses, his parents, his
9	spouse, and the parents of his spouse.
10	(5)(6) "Parish governing authority" or "governing authority of the parish"
11	with respect to Orleans Parish means the city council.
12	[Effective Date: Text of Paragraph (7) effective on January 1, 2026.]
13	(6)(7) "Party affiliation" and "affiliation with a political party" means the
14	party affiliation designated in the registrant's information on the state voter
15	registration computer system.
16	[Effective Date: Text of Paragraph (8) effective on January 1, 2026.]
17	(7)(8) "Party primary office" means an office of senator or representative in
18	the United States Congress, justice of the supreme court, the State Board of
19	Elementary and Secondary Education, and the Public Service Commission.
20	(8)(9) "Polling place" means any location where voting, either early or on
21	election day, is conducted pursuant to this Code.
22	(9)(10) "Precinct" means the smallest political unit of a ward having defined
23	geographical boundaries.
24	[Effective Date: Text of Paragraph (11) effective on January 1, 2026.]
25	(10)(11) "Primary election" means a primary election for a party primary
26	office or an office other than a party primary office.
27	(11)(12) "Signature" means the name of a person which is signed. Signature
28	in this Title includes the handwritten, electronic, or digitized name of an individual,
29	except when the handwritten signature of the individual is specifically required.

1 (12)(13) "Under an order of imprisonment" means a sentence of confinement, 2 whether or not suspended, whether or not the subject of the order has been placed on probation, with or without supervision, and whether or not the subject of the order 3 4 has been paroled. (13)(14) "Voter registration agency" means an office designated under R.S. 5 18:116(A) to perform voter registration activities. 6 (14)(15) "Voting district" means a geographical area composed of one or 7 8 more precincts in a parish in which every elector within that area votes in the same 9 congressional district, statewide board or commission district, judicial district, 10 Senate District, House of Representative District, parish governing authority district, 11 local and ward office district, municipal office district, and all other special election districts. 12 13 (15)(16) "Ward" means a police jury ward in a parish and in parishes having no police jury wards means the subdivision of the parish equivalent to a police jury 14 15 ward.

<u>Present law</u> defines the terms "federal election", "federal office", "immediate family", "parish governing authority" or "governing authority of the parish", "party affiliation" and "affiliation with a political party", "Party primary office", "polling place", "primary election", "signature", "under an order of imprisonment", "voter registration agency", "voting district", and "ward".

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and defines the term "deep fake" as synthetic media created with the intent to mislead or deceive others which depicts a candidate via video, image, or sound recording without his consent, except for any media which conspicuously displays a notice clearly identifying that the media is computer generated or not a genuine depiction of a person or events.
