INSURANCE PREMIUMS. Provides for a premium discount for certain military personnel. (8/1/24)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1482(A), (B), and (C)(1), relative to premium discounts on
3	automobile insurance policies for military reservists; to provide for premium
4	discounts; to require insurers provide a premium discount on automobile insurance
5	policies to military reservists; to provide insurers certain credit when offering a
6	premium discount for military reservists; to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 22:1482(A), (B), and (C)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted to
9	read as follows:
10	§1482. Military personnel premium discount; rebates; rating standards and methods
11	A. Every motor vehicle insurer authorized to transact business in this state
12	shall provide to active duty military, military reservist, Louisiana Air National
13	Guard, and Louisiana Army National Guard personnel based in this state a discount
14	of twenty-five percent of the premium on any automobile liability insurance policy
15	purchased in this state to cover motor vehicles owned by the military personnel.
16	B. Insurers providing the discount authorized by this Section to active duty
17	military, military reservist, Louisiana Air National Guard, and Louisiana Army

National Guard personnel are entitled to a credit that shall be applied toward the premium taxes imposed under R.S. 22:831 and 838 in an amount equal to the discount actually provided. To the extent an insurer's credit authorized in this Section exceeds the insurer's premium tax liability, the amount of credit not used to offset premium taxes due shall be considered overpaid taxes and shall be refundable to the insurer, without interest. Such insurers Insurers shall submit to the commissioner of insurance the documents, evidence, and proof required, in accordance with the rules and regulations adopted by the commissioner, to establish the discounts actually provided.

C. The commissioner shall adopt rules and regulations, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, to implement the provisions of this Section. The rules and regulations shall include and not be limited to the following:

(1) Provisions defining and delineating active duty military, <u>military</u> <u>reservists</u>, Louisiana Air National Guard, and Louisiana Army National Guard personnel who may receive the discount.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a 25% premium discount on automobile insurance policies for active duty military personnel, La. Air National Guard, and La. Army National Guard.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but extends the 25% premium discount on automobile insurance policies to servicemen in the military reserves.

<u>Present law</u> provides that insurers providing the automobile insurance premium discount authorized by <u>present law</u> to active duty military, La. Air National Guard, and La. Army National Guard personnel are entitled to a credit that is to be applied toward the premium taxes imposed under <u>present law</u> in an amount equal to the discount provided.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds insurers providing the automobile insurance premium discount to a military reservist are entitled to a credit that is to be applied toward the premium taxes imposed under present law in an amount equal to the discount applied.

<u>Present law</u> requires the commissioner of insurance to adopt rules and regulations that define and delineate active duty military, La. Air National Guard, and La. Army National Guard personnel who may receive the discount.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds military reservist are to be defined and delineated as to who may receive the discount.
