

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2024 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Original House Bill No. 646 by Representative Thompson

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, change "R.S. 38:2212(C)(1)" to "R.S. 38:2212 (P)(1)(a) and to enact R.S.
3 38:2212(C)(5)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 2, after "limitations" insert "and enforcements"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 3, after "projects" delete the remainder of the line

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, line 4, delete "limit for certain projects;" and insert "to provide for a contract
10 limit for public work projects to be completed by the Department of Culture, Recreation and
11 Tourism; to remove the ten day time frame for a public entity to post notice of a public
12 emergency in its official journal;"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, line 6, change "R.S. 38:2212(C)(1)" to "R.S. 38:2212(P)(1)(a)" and after
15 "reenacted" insert "R.S. 38:2212(C)(5) is hereby enacted"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

17 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 20 in their entirety

18 AMENDMENT NO. 7

19 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 in their entirety and insert the following:

22 (5) For public work related to projects to be completed by the Department
23 of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, the "contract limit" shall be one million dollars
24 per project, including labor, materials, and equipment as per the rates in the latest
25 edition of the Associated Equipment Dealers Rental Rate Book and administrative
26 overhead not to exceed fifteen percent, provided that beginning February 1, 2025,
27 and annually on February first of each subsequent year, the office of facility planning
28 and control within the division of administration shall adjust the "contract limit" by
29 an amount not to exceed the annual percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index
30 in the preceding year. The office of facility planning and control within the division
31 of administration shall publish the new contract limit for public works contract in the
32 Louisiana Register in January of each year."

34 P.(1)(a) This Section shall not apply in cases of public emergency where such
35 emergency has been certified to by the public entity and notice of such public
36 emergency shall, ~~within ten days thereof~~, be published in the official journal of the
37 public entity proposing or declaring such public emergency."
