<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the Louisiana Alzheimer's and Related Dementias Advisory Council within the Louisiana Department of Health.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a 22 member advisory council, terms of membership, reappointment, and criteria for reimbursement.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the council to conduct assessments of Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia in Louisiana and to develop and lead implementation of a five-year statewide plan to address Alzheimer's and related dementias.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the council shall hold its first meeting no later than Nov. 1, 2024, and quarterly thereafter.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the council to submit the five-year statewide plan to the governor and legislature no later than Nov. 1, 2025, and every five years thereafter.

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires the council to submit an annual written report of the progress of the plan to the governor's office and legislature no later than Nov. 1 of each year.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
