1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize Tuesday, March 19, 2024, as Louisiana Association of Public Charter
3 Schools, Charter Schools Day at the state capitol.

4 WHEREAS, charter schools, by law, are independent, tuition-free public schools that
5 are given greater educational and operational autonomy in exchange for the state's highest
6 level of performance-based accountability; and

7 WHEREAS, the state has demonstrated commitment to meeting its responsibility for
8 improving public schools by offering a competitive system of public education; and

9 WHEREAS, a first-class education prepares children to love lifelong learning and
10 to develop skills that enable them to participate in this technologically advanced global
11 economy; and

12 WHEREAS, Louisiana charter schools have brought new ideas, enthusiasm, and
13 strength to our public school system; and

14 WHEREAS, Louisiana has one of the top-ten strongest charter school laws in the
15 nation and has witnessed an increase in the number of operating charter schools and student
16 enrollment over nearly two decades; and

17 WHEREAS, Louisiana teaches approximately 94,000 children in its charter schools;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, charter schools increase learning opportunities for all pupils and provide
20 parents and students with expanded choices within the public school system; and

1 WHEREAS, the state joins the Louisiana Association of Public Charter Schools in
2 celebrating the accomplishments and contributions of charter schools to public education.

3 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
4 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Tuesday, March 19, 2024, as Louisiana
5 Association of Public Charter Schools, Charter Schools Day at the state capitol.
