11	board prescribes, accompanied by the fee required by this Chapter, and who
12	furnishes evidence to the board that, except as otherwise required by law, the
13	person meets all of the following criteria:
14	(a) Is at least twenty-one years of age.
15	(b) Is of good moral character.
16	(c) Has completed a master's degree in health service psychology from
17	an approved psychology program or equivalent defined by the board.
