BY SENATOR WOMACK AND REPRESENTATIVE RISER

ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Designates a portion of Louisiana Highway 425 in Franklin Parish as the "Lainey Wilson Highway". (8/1/24)

1 AN ACT

2 To provide relative to state highways; to designate a portion of Louisiana Highway 425 in

3 Franklin Parish as the "Lainey Wilson Highway"; to provide for restrictions on costs

4 of materials to the department; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 **Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the**

7 **portion of Louisiana Highway 15 in Franklin Parish from the intersection of Louisiana**

8 **Highway 577 to Big Creek Road is hereby designated as the "Lainey Wilson Highway".**

9 **Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby**

10 **directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided local or**

11 **private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs**

12 **for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed**

13 **the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.**
