Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, no municipality, parish, airport district, airport authority, or other political subdivision may grant a 12 13 lease of an entire airport nor may the public be deprived of its rightful, equal, and 14 uniform use of the airport or landing field or portion thereof, except at such times as 15 may be required in the interest of public safety and no exclusive concession, license, or lease agreement may be made relative to the business of servicing, repairing, or 16 furnishing of supplies for aircraft, or the sale, rental, or leasing of aircraft or flight 17 18 instruction. Prospective lessees providing such services must have complied with the 19 minimum aeronautical standards established by the lessor and approved by the office 20 of aviation of the Department of Transportation and Development.

23 All cities, towns, or other political subdivisions of this state in the 24 construction, expansion, lease, control, equipment, improvement, maintenance, operation, regulation, and policing of airports and landing fields for the use of 25 aircraft and in the acquisition of rights and privileges for lights and markers as 26 provided for in this Part shall obtain the consent and approval of the department of 27 28 all plans or proposed work in such construction, expansion, lease, control, 29 equipment, improvement, maintenance, operation, regulation, and policing and the 30 department shall have supervision thereof."
