A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Edgar Lawrence "Dooky" Chase III was born on May 10, 1949, in New Orleans, the cherished son of Edgar L. "Dooky" Chase Jr. and Leah Lange Chase, and he departed this life on February 21, 2024, leaving behind a legacy of love, leadership, and service; and

WHEREAS, growing up in the vibrant Treme neighborhood surrounded by his three sisters, Dooky was imbued with a strong sense of responsibility and community service, inspired by the example set by his family's renowned establishment, Dooky Chase's Restaurant, which served as a symbol of unity and tradition for generations; and

WHEREAS, Dooky Chase III, affectionately known as "The Prince", dedicated his life to making positive impacts on the world, from actively participating in voter registration initiatives with the NAACP's Youth Committee in the 1960s to becoming part of the first integrated class at Jesuit High School and serving as the first African American Class President at Loyola University New Orleans; and

WHEREAS, Dooky's commitment to service extended beyond academia to his military service as Captain in the United States Marine Corps, successful career at Price Waterhouse & Company and Cox Communications, and more than 20 years of dedicated leadership as the dean of the Business School at Dillard University, where he shaped young minds and assumed various faculty and administrative roles; and

WHEREAS, Dooky's greatest source of pride and joy was his enduring love and unwavering commitment to his wife, Alva Jean, with whom he recently celebrated 50 years of marriage, and his deep bond with his three sons, Travis, Trevor, and Edgar "Dook" IV, along with his cherished grandchildren, relatives, and friends; and

WHEREAS, Dooky Chase III leaves behind a legacy of service through his involvement in numerous boards, commissions, and councils, including the Chase Family Foundation, New Orleans Public Radio, Touro Hospital, The New Orleans Culinary and Hospitality Institute, and many others, where his dedication and leadership were instrumental in shaping the future of his community; and

WHEREAS, Dooky Chase III's joyful spirit, love for life's simple pleasures, and unwavering commitment to serving others will be dearly missed by all who had the privilege of knowing him, but his memory will forever be cherished and his legacy celebrated with gratitude and admiration.
