BRIDGES/FERRIES: Renames the Robinson Canal Bridge to the Lapeyrouse Bridge

1 AN ACT

2 To redesignate the "Robinson Canal Bridge" in Chauvin, Louisiana, as the "Lapeyrouse
3 Bridge"; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. The bridge on Louisiana Highway 56 over the Robinson Canal in
6 Chauvin, Louisiana, shall be known and is hereby redesignated as the "Lapeyrouse Bridge".

7 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
8 hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this redesignation
9 provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's
10 actual cost for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not exceed
11 the sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.

Abstract: Redesignates the "Robinson Canal Bridge" in Chauvin, Louisiana as the "Lapeyrouse Bridge".

Redesignates the "Robinson Canal Bridge" on La. Hwy. 56 in Chauvin, La. as the "Lapeyrouse Bridge".

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development (DOTD) or its contractors to erect and maintain appropriate signage reflecting this highway redesignation provided local or private monies are received by DOTD equal to its actual cost for material, fabrication, mounting, posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the sum of \$550 per sign.
