2	To amend and reenact R.S. 38:304(A), relative to levee commissioners; to provide for
3	requirements for levee commissioners; to provide relative to education requirements

5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 38:304(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§304. Appointment of members; residency and education requirements; filling of
8	vacancies
9	A. Any person appointed $\underline{as}$ a levee commissioner or levee and drainage
10	commissioner must have shall meet all of the following requirements;
11	(1) resided <u>Resides</u> in this state for the preceding two years;.
12	(2) resided <u>Resides</u> in the levee district for the preceding year,
13	(3) be Is a qualified voter of one of the parishes included in the district,
14	(4) Have or possess the equivalent of a high school diploma.
15	(5) and reside <b>Resides</b> in the district while serving as a member of the board.
