RETIREMENT BENEFITS. Removes the cap on the amount of any permanent benefit increase for recipients whose benefit is based on the record of someone who retired with at least 30 years of service credit. (gov sig)

Except as provided in Item (ii) of this Subparagraph, the The dollar 15 amount of such increase for any recipient shall not exceed five percent of the average 16

monthly benefit in payment to service retirees as of the end of the preceding fiscal

year.

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(ii) The dollar amount of any permanent benefit increase for a recipient whose benefit is based on the record of someone who retired with a minimum of thirty years of creditable service shall not be subject to the cap contained in Item (i) of this Subparagraph of five percent of the average monthly benefit in payment to service retirees.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the board of trustees of the Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund to provide permanent benefit increases (PBIs) to benefit recipients under certain circumstances. Limits any PBI to 2.5% of the normal monthly benefit being paid on the date of the increase. Further limits the dollar amount of any recipient's increase to 5% of the average monthly benefit in payment to service retirees as of the end of the preceding fiscal year, representing twice the maximum dollar amount of an increase payable to a service retiree receiving the average monthly benefit.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that the increase payable to any recipient whose benefit is based on the membership of someone with at least thirty years of creditable service shall not be subject to a cap on any PBI authorized by the board of trustees under present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
