| 11 | use. The certification shall be consistent with the American Heart Association,           |
| 12 | American Red Cross, or other national evidence-based emergency                            |
| 13 | cardiovascular care guidelines.   |
| 14 | <b>B.</b> The provisions of R.S. 9:2793 shall apply to any coach who is certified         |
| 15 | pursuant to this Section and performs cardiopulmonary resuscitation or first              |
| 16 | aid or uses an automatic external defibrillator in his capacity as a school coach.        |

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that, beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, any high school employee who serves as a coach for the school must obtain and maintain certification in CPR, first aid, and AED use.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the certification to be consistent with the American Heart Association, American Red Cross, or other national evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for a limitation of liability for any coach who performs cardiopulmonary resuscitation or first aid or uses an automatic external defibrillator in his capacity as a school coach.

Effective August 1, 2024.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill

- 1. Removes elementary and middle schools.
- 2. Requirements are only for high school coaches.
