SCHOOLS. Provides relative to parental consent for changes to an individualized education program. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 17:1946.1, relative to parental consent; to provide relative to an individualized
3	education program; to provide for written informed consent from a parent or other
4	legal guardian; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 17:1946.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1946.1. Parental consent; exception
8	A. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a local
9	education agency shall obtain written informed consent from a student's parent
10	or legal guardian before it can initially provide a student with special education
11	courses or related services in any setting.
12	B. If the individualized education program placement requires a
13	reduction or removal of any special education course or related service, the
14	local education agency shall obtain written informed consent from the student's
15	parent or other legal guardian before the change can be implemented. In the
16	event the student's individualized education program is changed for any reason,
17	the local education agency shall obtain written informed consent from the

parent or legal guardian before the change can be implemented.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

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<u>Proposed law</u> requires local education agencies to obtain written informed consent from a student's parent or other legal guardian before it can initially provide a student with special education or related services in any setting.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires local education agencies to obtain written informed consent from the student's parent or other legal guardian before a reduction or removal of special education or related services from the initial individualized education program can be implemented.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the local education agency to obtain written informed consent from the student's parent or other legal guardian before a change for any reason can be implemented.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Agriculture, Forestry, Aquaculture, and Rural Development to the original bill

1. Requires parental consent before changing a student's individualized education program for any reason.
