35 36 37	(3)(a) For the 2026-2027 school year, a student is initially eligible if the student is from a family with a total income at or below four hundred percent of the federal poverty guidelines and meets one of the following criteria:
38 39 40	(i) The student is entering kindergarten.  (ii) The student was enrolled in a public school in the 2025-2026 school year.
41 42 43 44	(b) Beginning in the 2027-2028 school year and annually thereafter, the only requirement for a student to be eligible for an educational savings account pursuant to this Paragraph is that the student is from a family with a total income at or below four hundred percent of the federal poverty guidelines.

12	§4037.13. Fraud or theft of program funds
13	A. Any fraud or theft of program funds shall be prosecuted as the crime
14	of government benefits fraud pursuant to R.S. 14:70.9. The department shall
15	display on its website and include in its contracts that any fraud or theft of
16	program funds includes the act of any person, whether acting as an individual
17	or a juridical person, who acts with intent to defraud the program by doing any
18	of the following:
19	(1) Presents for allowance or payment any false or fraudulent claim for
20	furnishing services, merchandise, or payments.
21	(2) Knowingly submits false information for the purpose of obtaining
22	greater compensation than that to which he is legally entitled for furnishing
23	services, merchandise, or payments.
24	(3) Knowingly submits false information for the purpose of obtaining
25	authorization for furnishing services, merchandise, or payments.
26	(4) Knowingly makes or causes to be made a false statement or
27	representation of material fact on an application or form for assistance, goods,
28	services, or payments when the false statement or representation is made for the
29	purpose of determining the person's eligibility to receive benefits or payments.
30	(5) Knowingly conceals or fails to disclose any material fact affecting the
31	applicant's or recipient's initial or continued eligibility to receive benefits or
32	payments.
33	B. In addition to the venue established by Code of Criminal Procedure
34	Articles 611 and 614, venue for prosecution pursuant to this Section shall also
35	be appropriate in the Nineteenth Judicial District Court, parish of East Baton
36	Rouge."
