Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 313 by Senator Edmonds

## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 14, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:

3 "(5) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a
 4 participating nonpublic school shall provide instruction in accordance with the
 5 state content standards promulgated by the state Board of Elementary and
 6 Secondary Education, but may utilize instructional material of their own
 7 choosing."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 2

9 On page 14, delete lines 27 through 29 and on page 15, delete lines 1 through 12, and insert
10 the following:

11	"A. A participating nonpublic school shall ensure that participating
12	students are administered all examinations required pursuant to the school and
13	district accountability system at the prescribed grade level, including the end
14	of course test that is administered to public school students. The results of the
15	test shall be provided to the parent.
16	<b>B.</b> A scholarship cohort index that is calculated in a manner that is
17	substantially similar to the school performance score outline in Bulletin 111, as
18	promulgated by the state Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, shall
19	be produced for each participating nonpublic school after the school year in
20	which assessments are taken. The scholarship cohort index shall measure only
21	the participating students who are enrolled in the nonpublic school.
22	<b>C.</b> The scholarship cohort index and the corresponding letter grade using
23	the scale applicable to school performance scores for each participating
24	nonpublic school shall be posted on the website maintained by the department
25	and otherwise published in the same manner as the annual school performance
26	score that is attributable to public schools.
27	<b>D.</b> If the participating nonpublic school receives a scholarship cohort
28	index less than fifty on a scale of one hundred and fifty in the second year of
29	<u>participation or in any year thereafter, the school shall not enroll any additional</u>
30	participating students.
31	<b>E. If a participating nonpublic school for three consecutive years receives</b>
32	a scholarship cohort index below fifty, the nonpublic school shall be ineligible
33	<u>to participate in the program in the subsequent year.</u>
34	<b>F. A participating nonpublic school shall perform all screeners and other</b>
35	testing mandated to be administered to any public school student, including but
36	not limited to the literacy screener required in R.S. 17:24.9."
