TOPS: Provides for the termination of the TOPS-Tech Award beginning with the 2029-2030 award year

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:5002(A)(1) and (2) and (G)(1) and 5029(B)(3)(b)(ii) and
3	(C)(introductory paragraph), to enact R.S. 17:5123, and to repeal R.S. 17:5002(D)
4	and (E)(2), 5024(A)(1)(d) and (B)(1)(d), 5026, 5027(D)(1), and 5042, relative to the
5	Taylor Opportunity Program for Students; to provide for the termination of the
6	TOPS-Tech award; to provide for applicability and effectiveness; and to provide for
7	related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 17:5123 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§5123. Termination of the TOPS-Tech award; transitional provisions
11	A. Notwithstanding any provision of this Chapter to the contrary, the TOPS-
12	Tech award shall terminate upon the completion of the 2028-2029 award year as
13	provided in this Subsection.
14	B.(1) Students who graduate from high school through the 2026-2027 school
15	year may qualify for a TOPS-Tech award pursuant to this Chapter.
16	(2) Students who enter high school in the 2024-2025 school year or thereafter
17	shall not qualify for a TOPS-Tech award.
18	(3) Beginning with the 2029-2030 award year, the only awards provided
19	pursuant to this Chapter shall be Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards.

10	participating in the program provided by R.S. 29:36.1 for persons serving in the

Abstract: Provides for the termination of the TOPS-Tech award beginning with the 2029-2030 award year.

<u>Present law</u> provides for provides for the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) as a merit scholarship program. Provides for four award levels, one of which is TOPS-Tech, a two-year award.

Proposed law:

- (1) Terminates the TOPS-Tech award at the end of the 2028-2029 award year.
- (2) Provides that students graduating from high school through the 2026-2027 school year may qualify for a TOPS-Tech award.
- (3) Provides that students entering high school in the 2024-2025 school year or thereafter shall not qualify for a TOPS-Tech award.
- (4) Provides that beginning with the 2029-2030 award year, the only TOPS awards provided shall be Opportunity, Performance, and Honors awards.

Effective July 1, 2029, except for transitional provisions, which are effective July 1, 2024.
