HOUSE BILL NO. 186

PARISH/ORDINANCES: Provides relative to maximum penalties for violations of ordinances in Jefferson Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:1243(B), relative to the parish of Jefferson; to provide
3 relative to parish ordinances; to provide relative to the violation of such ordinances;
4 to provide relative to the penalties for any such violation; and to provide for related
5 matters.

6 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
7 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
8 Louisiana.

9 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

10 Section 1. R.S. 33:1243(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

11 * * *

12 B.(1) In the parish of Jefferson the ~~maximum~~ penalty which may be imposed
13 for violation of any parish ordinance is not subject to Paragraph (A)(1) of this
14 Section and shall be a fine of five hundred dollars and imprisonment of six months
15 in the parish jail as provided by ordinance adopted by the parish governing authority.

16 (2) ~~Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (1), the governing authority~~
17 ~~of any such parish may provide for a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars and a~~
18 ~~sentence of imprisonment not to exceed six months in the parish jail for violation of~~
19 ~~any ordinance prohibiting the dumping of trash, debris, refuse, garbage, other solid~~
20 ~~and liquid waste, greases and oils, such as but not limited to cooking oil and fats,~~

violation of certain ordinances, including any ordinance prohibiting the dumping of trash, debris, garbage, or other solid and liquid waste.

Proposed law provides that Jefferson Parish is not subject to maximum penalties provided by present law.
