- 11"C. (1) There is hereby established a district attorneys oversight12commission that shall be composed of the following members:
- 13(a) Eight district attorneys appointed by the board of directors of the14Louisiana District Attorneys Association, or its successor, whose judicial district15is located, in whole or in part, within the boundary of a single member district16of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education.
- 17 (b) One retired judge appointed by a majority of the sitting justices of
 18 the Louisiana Supreme Court.
- 19(c) One attorney appointed by the governor from a list of names20submitted by the board of directors of the Louisiana Association of Criminal21Defense Lawyers, or its successor.
- 22(d) One attorney appointed by the Louisiana Public Defender Oversight23Board, or its successor.
- 24(e) Two members appointed from different political parties by the25speaker of the Louisiana House of Representatives.
- 26(f) Two members appointed from different political parties by the27president of the Louisiana Senate.
- (2) The district attorneys oversight commission shall have the authority
 to approve or disapprove of any action of the attorney general to intervene in,
 supercede any attorney representing the state in any criminal action, prosecute,
 or initiate a prosecution of any criminal case in the state when the attorney
 general seeks to do so without the permission of either the district attorney
 having prosecutorial power in the case or the court which would have original
 jurisdiction."
