Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to Original Senate Bill No. 185 by Senator Seabaugh

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 13:4163(E)(2)(c)" insert "and (F)(3), (4), and (5)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 6, after "court costs;" insert "to provide for exceptions;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 14, after "(c)" delete "**If a legal deadline has run,**" and change "a" to "A"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 2, after line 19, insert the following:

9 "F. (1) * * *

11 **(3) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to proceedings wherein a**
12 **temporary restraining order, protective order, preliminary injunction, permanent**
13 **injunction, court-approved consent agreement resulting from an action brought, or**
14 **order issued pursuant to any of the following:**

15 **(a) R.S. 46:2131 et seq., R.S. 46:2151, R.S. 46:2171 et seq., R.S. 46:2181 et seq.,**
16 **R.S. 9:361 et seq., R.S. 9:372, Children's Code Article 1564 et seq., Code of Civil**
17 **Procedure Articles 3604 and 3607.1, or peace bonds pursuant to Code of Criminal**
18 **Procedure Article 30(B).**

19 **(b) Code of Criminal Procedure Articles, including 871.1, regarding the**
20 **disposition, sentence, or bail condition of a criminal matter.**

21 **(c) R.S. 46:1846 to prohibit communications between offenders and victims**
22 **following a charge or after sentencing for any crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2,**
23 **felony sex offense as defined in R.S. 46:1844(W), felony human trafficking-related**
24 **offense as defined in R.S. 46:1844(W), or a felony offense committed upon a family**
25 **member, household member, or dating partner as defined by R.S. 46:2132, or upon an**
26 **immediate family member of such person.**

27 **(d) R.S. 15:574.4.2(A)(5) as condition of a parole release which requires that the**
28 **parolee stay away from any specific person, when the order is issued for the purpose**
29 **of preventing violent or threatening acts, harassment against, contact or**
30 **communication with, or physical proximity to, another person to prevent witness**
31 **intimidation, domestic abuse, stalking, dating violence, or sexual assault.**

32 **(4) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to proceedings pursuant to the**
33 **Domestic Violence Prevention Firearm Transfer Act and Code of Criminal Procedure**
34 **Article 1001, et seq.**

35 **(5) The provisions of this Section shall not apply to proceedings for writs of**
36 **habeas corpus for the determination and enforcement of rights to the custody of a**
37 **minor or for the release of a person in custody in which the family court has original**
38 **jurisdiction.**
