Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Original Senate Bill No. 493 by Senator Hodges

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and on page 3 delete 3 "34:851.5" and insert "R.S. 56:109.4(A) and to repeal R.S. 56:109.4(C)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 7, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 8 through 6 17, delete page 2, and on page 3 delete lines 1 though 15 and insert the following:

7 "R.S.56:109.4 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

8 §109.4. Use of airboats on the Maurepas Swamp Wildlife Management Area

9 A. Use of airboats on any public waterway shall be subject to free and 10 unrestricted navigation by motorboat within the Maurepas Swamp Wildlife Management Area shall be limited to airboat trails. Such trails shall be established The commission may 11 regulate airboats by rules and regulations promulgated by the commission, pursuant to the 12 13 Administrative Procedure Act, where airboat operation is feasible and in a manner to best protect public safety and wildlife resources and habitats. An airboat trail shall be established 14 15 only on trails or rights of way existing as of February 1, 2018. Such rules and regulations 16 shall also include the following:

17 (1) Require the exhaust of any internal combustion engine used on any airboat
18 operated on airboat trails be equipped with an automotive-style factory muffler, underwater
19 exhaust, or other manufactured device capable of adequately muffling the sound of the
20 exhaust of the engine.

(2) Limit the size of the internal combustion engine of any airboat operated on
airboat trails to no greater than three hundred fifty-one cubic inches.

(3) Require every person using an airboat trail to possess a WMA hunting permit,
to notify the department annually of the airboat's registration number, and to make such
airboat available for inspection by department personnel.

26 (4) Prohibit the use of established airboat trails by airboats between September first
27 and the following January thirty-first.
