2 3	In House Committee Amendment No. 7 by the House Committee on Commerce (#2915), on page 1, delete lines 21 through 36 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
4	"D.(1) In order to receive a special permit as a registered natural hair braider,
5	a person shall meet all of the following requirements:
6	(a) Review training materials prepared by the board on sanitation and safety.
7	(b) Pass a fifteen-question examination prepared by the board on sanitation
8	and safety.
9	(c) Complete the board's application for a natural hair braiding permit and
10	submit the application and completed examination to the board by mail, in person,
11	or on the board's website.
12	(d) Pay applicable fees not to exceed twenty-five dollars.
13	(2) The board shall issue a special permit upon verifying a person has passed
14	the examination by at least seventy percent.
15	(3) A person who holds a valid special permit issued pursuant to this
16	Subsection shall be exempt from all of the following requirements:
17	(a) A certificate of registration for beauty shops or salons.
18	(b) Renewal of the special permit.
19	(c) Payment of additional fees for the maintenance of the permit.
20	(d) Taking any additional examination.
21	(4) The board shall make the training materials, examination, and application
22	available at its office and on its website."
