WHEREAS, Aleah Finnegan's clutch performance and score of 9.95 punctuated the final rotation with an exclamation point that left Head Coach Jay Clark speechless and kicked off a joyous celebration for the purple and gold; and

WHEREAS, her teammate Haileigh Bryant also contributed a 9.95 score of her own en route to becoming the NCAA all-around national champion and forever enshrining her legacy among the all-time greats; and

WHEREAS, the championship meet win was LSU's 24th consecutive victory to finish the season with a stellar record of 31-3, causing the Tigers to become just the eighth school to capture an NCAA gymnastics title; and
