MEDICAID. Creates a pilot program for Medicaid recipients to utilize portable oxygen concentrators. (8/1/24)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 46:460.76.1, relative to a pilot program for Medicaid recipients to utilize
3	portable oxygen concentrators; to provide for a pilot program developed by the
4	Louisiana Department of Health; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 46:460.76.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§460.76.1. Medicaid pilot program; portable oxygen concentrator
8	A.(1) The legislature finds that Louisiana Medicaid covers portable
9	oxygen concentrators to Medicaid beneficiaries under twenty-one years of age,
10	if deemed medically necessary, through the Early and Periodic Screening,
11	Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) benefit. However, for individuals over the
12	age of twenty-one, Medicaid only covers portable oxygen concentrators for
13	travel to medical appointments and treatment.

16	policy could greatly improve the quality of life for Louisiana residents who

Proposed law authorizes the department to limit the number of concentrators that are covered and to submit a utilization report to the legislature.
