Proposed legislation provides that children who are mentally stressed and may be suffering from anxiety and whose attendance in school may endanger their academic performance are allowed to be absent from school for not more than two days per semester. Requires parents provide the school with the recommendation of a medical doctor or mental health professional and that any school work the child misses due to the mental health absence must be made up before the semester ends.
