Amendments proposed by Senator Fields to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 432 by Senator Edmonds

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

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On page 2, delete lines 20 through 29 and on page 3, delete lines 1 through 16 and insert: 2

3	"F. (1) The district shall require the metering and monitoring of every
4	well under the jurisdiction of the board. The district may allow for well owners
5	to directly connect their meters to the district's on-site monitoring system
6	provided that the owner's meter meets the same technical specifications for
7	accuracy as the meters provided by the district within a maximum deviation of
8	less than two percent.
9	(2) The owner's meter shall allow for real-time monitoring by the
10	district's monitoring equipment. The district shall prescribe and conduct any
11	audits and quality assurance or quality control programs as determined
12	necessary by the district to assure the validity and accuracy of the collected
13	data.
14	(3)(a) Well owners who use their own meters shall provide calibration
15	certificates for each meter from an independent certified laboratory according
16	to the frequency prescribed by the meter manufacturer, but in no case less than
17	every two years.
18	(b) The district may install a second meter on an owner's well to verify
19	the accuracy of the owner's meter. If the owner's meter is determined by the
20	district to be inaccurate, the owner shall be required to recalibrate the meter at
21	his expense and the district shall continue to use the district's meter until the
22	owner's meter is capable of meeting the district's accuracy specification
