27	discrimination on the basis of political, ideological, or religious beliefs against
28	any organization or the organization's leaders or members of the organization in
29	<u>a manner that does any of the following</u> :
30	(1) Affirm and adhere to Restricts the organization's sincerely held religious
31	beliefs or the political or ideological beliefs of the organization.
32	(2) Comply Restricts compliance with the organization's standards of
33	conduct with respect to free speech and First Amendment protected expressive
34	<u>activities</u> .
35	(3) Further <u>Restricts</u> the organization's mission or purpose, as defined by the
36	organization with respect to free speech and First Amendment protected
37	<u>expressive activities</u> .
38	(4) Requires the organization to accept elected officers, choose leaders,
39	or accept members who are not members of the same religion or the same
40	political party or who do not share the same ideological beliefs if to do so would
41	violate the organization's standards of conduct."

1	Each public postsecondary education institution shall develop policies,
2	regulations, and expectations of students regarding free expression and association
3	speech and First Amendment protected expressive activities on campus that are
4	consistent with this Part and the policies of its management board. The policies shall
5	outline the rights of students, administrators, faculty, and staff and shall:

7	(4) Include a statement that each institution shall strive to ensure the
8	fullest degree of protection for each student's political views and freedom of
9	association.
10	(5) Include a statement that every professor or instructor at the
11	institution shall be prohibited from imposing the professor's political views on
12	students in violation of R.S. 17:3399.39.
13	(6) Include a statement that the institution is engaged in protecting its
14	students from student-on-student discriminatory harrassment pursuant to R.S.
15	<u>17:3399.32(F).</u>

17	§3399.38. Conflict with other laws
18	A. The provisions of this Part shall supersede and control to the extent of any
19	conflict with any other provision of law and shall govern a public postsecondary
20	education institution's obligation to address all forms of discriminatory harassment
21	perpetrated by one student on another, including sexual harassment.
22	B. Nothing in this Section shall be construed to limit or deny any
23	protections or remedies available to a student pursuant to any other provision
24	<u>of law.</u>
25	§3399.39. Right to individual dignity; each student's right to be free from
26	discrimination on the basis of political ideas, affiliations, or
27	ideology
28	A. Article I, Section 3 of the Constitution of Louisiana guarantees that
29	each person, including a college or university student, has the right to
30	"individual dignity" and further provides that protections are guaranteed
31 32	against discrimination based upon the student's "political ideas or affiliations".
32 33	B. A public postsecondary education management board shall make reasonable efforts to protect students from discrimination on the basis of
33 34	political ideas, affiliations, or ideology.
34 35	C. No professor or instructor who teaches a class to students at an
35 36	institution of higher education shall impose the professor's or instructor's
30 37	political views onto students and, therefore, shall be prohibited from doing any
38	of the following:
39	(a) Requiring a student to attend a political protest or engage in any
40	other political activity outside the classroom that aligns with the political views
41	of the professor or instructor.
42	(b) Requiring a student to participate in a certain political activity
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43	outside the classroom as a condition of obtaining the letter grade to which the
