13	B. As used in this Section, the term "qualified retired law enforcement
14	officer" means an individual who meets all of the following:

16	(2) Before such separation, was an active, full-time employee or reserve
17	officer of a state or municipal law enforcement agency or sheriff's office and is
18	certified in the use of firearms by the Peace Officer Standards and Training Council.

20	F. For the purposes of this Section, "reserve officer" means a reserve or
21	auxiliary municipal police officer who meets all the qualifications provided in
22	R.S. 14:95(G)(3).
