- 8 identifying changes in household circumstances for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
- 9 Program benefit allotments, the office of juvenile justice shall report identifying information
- to the department of each juvenile placed under the custody of the office of juvenile justice
- for a sentence of nine months of longer. The Department of Children and Family Services
- shall determine the required information necessary to identify the juvenile and the juvenile's
- 13 household."
- 14 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- On page 1, line 14, after "majority" insert "at the time of release"
- 16 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- On page 1, line 16, after "custody." insert "For purposes of this Section, the age of majority
- means a child under the age of twenty-two."
- 19 AMENDMENT NO. 6
- 20 On page 1, line 19, after "custody." insert "If the office of juvenile justice is unable to
- 21 provide notice forty-five days prior to release due to a modification of a disposition by a
- 22 court, the office shall notify the department within twenty-four hours of receipt of the
- 23 modified disposition."

- 25 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert the following:
- 26 "D. Upon receipt of a report from the office of juvenile justice pursuant to this
- 27 Section, the Department of Children and Family Services shall adjust the Supplemental
- Nutrition Assistance Program benefits for the juvenile's household to reflect the change in
- 29 <u>circumstance.</u>"
