23 Citations issued for traffic enforcement device violations shall contain 24 on the back of the citation a description of a process wherein the recipient may 25 send in an affidavit attesting that at the time of the violation the person who 26 received the notice of violation was not the owner of the vehicle or the vehicle 27 was in the care, custody, and control of another at the time of the violation. If 28 the recipient attests that he was not the driver of the vehicle at the time of the 29 violation, he must provide the legal name and address of the driver in the 30 affidavit."
