23	A. Each local public school board shall adopt a policy to require that each
24	school nurse participates in an in-service training program of at least one hour
25	relative to sickle cell disease. The school boards shall use the instructional materials
26	provided in accordance with Subsection C of this Section. The training may be
27	incorporated into an existing in-service training program.
28	B. The program shall include information on symptoms of and treatments
29	for sickle cell disease in children and shall include, at minimum, the following:
30	(1) The medical needs students may have in a school setting related to the
31	physiological complications of the disease, including but not limited to anemia,
32	sensitivity to heat and cold, increased urinary frequency, pain episodes, fevers, and
33	stroke.
34	(2) Possible accommodations in the classroom, at recess, and during school
35	meal times for students who experience health problems associated with sickle cell
36	disease during the school day.
37	(3) Methods for communicating with parents and other school personnel in
38	order to support positive academic outcomes for students with sickle cell disease.
39	C. The Louisiana Sickle Cell Commission shall develop the instructional
40	materials, which shall be made available on the Louisiana State Board of Nursing's
41	website.

§3996. Charter schools; exemptions; requirements

B. Notwithstanding any state law, rule, or regulation to the contrary and except as may be otherwise specifically provided for in an approved charter, a charter school established and operated in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter and its approved charter and the school's officers and employees shall be exempt from all statutory mandates or other statutory requirements that are applicable to public schools and to public school officers and employees except for the following laws otherwise applicable to public schools with the same grades:

(82) Sickle cell disease training for school nurses, R.S. 17:436.5.
