- in a career progression group as defined by a Department of State Civil Service or State
- 11 Police Commission rule."

- On page 1, after line 16, insert:
- "Section 3. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2025; if vetoed by the
- governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on
- the day following such approval by the legislature or January 1, 2025, whichever is later."
