Awards and amounts \* 26 D.(1) Except as otherwise provided in this Subsection, a student who is eligible for 27 28 a TOPS-Tech Award pursuant to this Chapter and who is enrolled: 29 (a) In an eligible public college or university that does not offer an academic 30 undergraduate degree at the baccalaureate level in those associate's degree or other 31 shorter-term training and education programs that are aligned to state workforce 32 priorities as determined by the Board of Regents and the Louisiana Workforce 33 Investment Council shall be awarded by the state an amount determined by the 34 administering agency to equal the tuition charged by the college or university during 35 the 2016-2017 academic year. If the Board of Regents and the Louisiana Workforce 36 Investment Council determine that a program is no longer aligned with those 37 priorities, an otherwise eligible student who had previously received an award and 38 enrolled in that program may continue to use the award. (b) In an eligible college or university other than as provided for in Subparagraph (a) 39 40 of this Paragraph in those associate's degree or other shorter-term training education 41 programs that are aligned to state workforce priorities as determined by the Board 42 of Regents and the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council, shall be awarded by 43 the state an amount determined by the administering agency to equal the weighted 44 average of the tuition amounts charged to students attending an eligible public 45 college or university that does not offer an academic undergraduate degree at the 46 baccalaureate level during the 2016-2017 academic year. If the Board of Regents and 47 the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council determine that a program is no longer 48 aligned with those priorities, an otherwise eligible student who had previously 49 received an award and enrolled in that program may continue to use the award. 50 (2) A student who graduated prior to the 2016-2017 school year, who is eligible for 51 a TOPS-Tech Award pursuant to this Chapter, and who is enrolled: 52 (a) In an eligible college or university that does not offer an academic undergraduate 53 degree at the baccalaureate level, shall be awarded by the state an amount determined 54 by the administering agency to equal the tuition charged by the college or university 55 during the 2016-2017 academic year. 56 (b) In an eligible college or university other than as provided for in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be awarded by the state an amount determined by the 57 58 administering agency to equal the weighted average of the tuition amounts charged

  - E.(1) <u>D.(1)</u> No student shall be eligible for tuition payment pursuant to this Section for the Opportunity Award, the Performance Award, or the Honors Award for more than eight semesters or an equivalent number of units in an eligible institution which operates on a schedule based on units other than semesters, unless an extension is granted by the administering agency in accordance with its rules.
- 10F. E. No student shall receive a grant pursuant to this Section in an amount greater11than the tuition charged by the institution attended or, if the student is the recipient12of a Performance or an Honors Award as provided for in Subsection C of this13Section, the amount stipulated therein. The institution shall credit any amount in14excess of the cost of tuition to the student's account to pay room and board or other15cost of attendance.
