1 AN ACT 2 To enact R.S. 18:1401(G), relative to objections to candidacy; to provide for penalties for 3 attesting to false information in a notice of candidacy; and to provide for related 4 matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 18:1401(G) is hereby enacted to read as follows: 7 §1401. Objections to candidacy; contests of elections; contests of certification of 8 recall petition; parties authorized to institute actions; penalties 9 10 G. Court costs and attorney fees shall be assessed against a candidate who 11 knowingly attests to false information in a notice of candidacy. In addition, the court 12 may impose any other sanctions that the court deems appropriate.
