<u>Present law</u> (C.C. Art. 3454) provides that in computing a prescriptive period, the day that marks the commencement of prescription is not counted.

<u>Present law</u> provides that prescription accrues upon the expiration of the last day of the prescriptive period, and if that day is a legal holiday, prescription accrues upon the expiration of the next day that is not a legal holiday.

<u>Proposed law</u> clarifies that prescription accrues upon the expiration of the last day of the prescriptive period, and if that day is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, prescription accrues upon the expiration of the next day that is not a legal holiday.

Effective August 1, 2025.
