<u>Present law</u> creates the Natural and Scenic Rivers System to protect, conserve, and replenish state water bodies and designates certain rivers, streams, and bayous that are part of the system.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and removes the following water bodies in St. Tammany Parish from the system: Holmes Bayou, Bradley Slough (Bayou), Wilson Slough (Bayou), Morgan River, Bayou LaCombe, Bayou Cane, Bayou Chinchuba, and Bayou Liberty.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits channelization, clearing and snagging, channel realignment and reservoir construction on water bodies in the system.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and creates certain exceptions for the portion of the West Pearl River lying between Lock 1 and the Rigolets, from August 1, 2025, to August 1, 2033.

Effective August 1, 2025.
