Abstract: Provides relative to disclosure of an attorney's interest in a case in certain circumstances.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if an attorney reasonably expects to earn a fee equal to or exceeding \$1,000, the attorney shall file a disclosure of his interest in the case with the court.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if an attorney in his individual capacity or through an interest in a business entity reasonably expects to earn an amount equal to or exceeding \$1,000, the attorney shall file a disclosure of his interest in the case with the court.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if an attorney violates <u>proposed law</u> he shall be subject to sanctions by the court, and the clerk of court in which the case is filed shall file a complaint against the attorney for the violation with the La. Attorney Disciplinary Board.
