Proposed law provides legislative intent regarding the integrity of the Medicaid program.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the La. Dept. of Health to implement certain program integrity measures to verify ongoing Medicaid eligibility, including checking information provided by state and federal agencies.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the La. Dept. of Health to use an enhanced verification platform to verify recipient eligibility.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the La. Dept. of Health from accepting eligibility from certain exchanges established by federal law, utilizing ex parte renewals, or accepting self-attestation of eligibility information.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the La. Dept. of Health to make certain noncompliance and fraud information available to the public on its website.

Proposed law defines income for the purposes of determining Medicaid eligibility.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
