To enact R.S. 33:4712.26, relative to property and buildings; to provide relative to the
naming of public buildings by the city of Lafayette; to authorize the governing
authority of the city of Lafayette to name the Heymann Park Complex in honor of
a living person; and to provide for related matters.
Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 33:4712.26 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
§4712.26. Naming of Heymann Park Complex
Notwithstanding R.S. 42:267 or any other law to the contrary, the
governing authority of the city of Lafayette may name the Heymann Park
Complex in honor of John "Cush" Leblanc.

Present law (R.S. 42:267) prohibits the naming of public buildings after living persons.
