## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

This bill may increase expenditures for the Louisiana State Board of Dentistry by approximately \$1,200 in fiscal year 2027 due to the relocation of its office from East Baton Rouge Parish to Orleans Parish.

An official from the Louisiana State Board of Dentistry indicated that the Board intends to relocate its office to Orleans Parish. This relocation is estimated to cost approximately \$1,200 for hiring a moving company. This expenditure is anticipated to occur in fiscal year 2027 and is based on the Board's previous office move in 2021, which cost \$1,060, adjusted for inflation. We were informed that that the lease amount paid in New Orleans will be similar to the lease amount paid in East Baton Rouge.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
