2 To designate Tuesday, April 22, 2025, as Coca-Cola Day at the Louisiana State Capitol and to commend Coca-Cola UNITED for its outstanding legacy, economic impact, and 3 enduring commitment to the people and communities of Louisiana. 4 5 WHEREAS, Coca-Cola UNITED's story in Louisiana began in 1906, when visionary entrepreneur Thomas Daigre founded the Baton Rouge Coca-Cola Bottling Company in a 6 7 modest building at the corner of Europe and St. Louis streets in Baton Rouge, establishing 8 a cornerstone for a company that would grow to become an integral part of Louisiana's 9 economic and cultural fabric; and 10 WHEREAS, for more than 130 years, Coca-Cola UNITED, now a vital privately 11 owned Coca-Cola bottler, has proudly operated in Louisiana, expanding its offerings to a diverse portfolio of more than 750 beverage options and placing a growing emphasis on 12 13 low-calorie and sugar-free choices, reflecting its commitment to evolving consumer needs and health-conscious lifestyles; and 14 WHEREAS, Coca-Cola UNITED currently operates seven facilities throughout 15 Louisiana - including five sales and distribution centers and two production plants-providing 16 meaningful employment to over 2,400 dedicated Louisianians and contributing significantly 17 18 to the state's economy; and

1	WHEREAS, as a locally owned and operated employer, Coca-Cola UNITED sustains
2	thousands of Louisiana jobs and continues to be a preferred beverage provider for consumers
3	across the state, contributing an estimated \$937 million in economic impact annually, plus
4	an additional \$38 million through purchases from local suppliers-supporting over 14,730
5	jobs in related industries; and
6	WHEREAS, over the past five years, Coca-Cola UNITED has demonstrated its
7	long-term commitment to Louisiana by investing over \$150 million in capital improvements,
8	strengthening infrastructure, and ensuring continued growth; and
9	WHEREAS, Coca-Cola UNITED is deeply committed to community well-being,
10	generously supporting civic and charitable organizations across Louisiana with
11	approximately \$6.5 million in annual investments in community programs; and
12	WHEREAS, the company has also taken a national leadership role in addressing
13	childhood obesity; and
14	WHEREAS, in 2006, Coca-Cola UNITED, as part of the American Beverage
15	Association, partnered with the Alliance for a Healthier Generation to reduce beverage
16	calories in schools by 94%, and voluntarily removed all full-calorie beverages from
17	elementary, middle, and high schools, implementing policies to support healthier
18	environments for children; and
19	WHEREAS, Coca-Cola UNITED's actions are guided by the enduring core values
20	of quality, excellence, integrity, and respect - values that have shaped its relationships with
21	employees, consumers, customers, and communities alike, while advancing initiatives in
22	sustainability, education, technology, and innovation.
23	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
24	does hereby designate Tuesday, April 22, 2025, as Coca-Cola Day at the Louisiana State
25	Capitol and does hereby commend Coca-Cola UNITED for its lasting legacy, significant
26	economic contributions, steadfast community engagement and impactful efforts to promote
27	healthier lifestyles and address childhood obesity across Louisiana and beyond.
