INSURERS. Requires health insurers to cover proton therapy for cancer patients. (8/1/25)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact R.S. 22:1060.18, relative to cancer treatment; to require health insurers to provide
3	coverage for proton therapy treatment for cancer patients; and to provide for related
4	matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 22:1060.18 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1060.18. Required coverage for proton therapy treatment for cancer
8	A. No health insurance issuer shall deny coverage of proton therapy or
9	proton beam therapy for the treatment of cancer as recommended by the
10	American Society for Radiation Oncology practice guidelines.
11	B. The coverage provided in this Section may be subject to annual
12	deductibles, coinsurance, and copayment provisions as are consistent with those
13	established under the health coverage plan.
14	C. The provisions of this Section do not apply to a plan providing
15	coverage for excepted benefits as described in R.S. 22:1061, limited health
16	benefit insurance plans, and short-term policies that have a term of less than
17	twelve months.

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1 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply to any new policy, contract, 2 program, or health coverage plan issued on or after January 1, 2026. Any policy, contract, 3 or health coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2026, shall convert to conform to the 4 provisions of this Act on or before the renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2026.

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<u>Present law</u> requires health insurance plans to provide coverage for certain treatments for cancer.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, and adds proton therapy treatment for cancer as recommended by the American Society for Radiation Oncology practice guidelines to the list of treatments health insurance plans must cover.

<u>Proposed law</u> applies to any new policy, contract, program, or health coverage plan issued on or after January 1, 2026. Any policy, contract, or health coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2026, shall convert to conform to the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> on or before the renewal date, but no later than January 1, 2026.

Effective August 1, 2025.
