ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Designates portions of certain roadways in honor of fallen law enforcement officers. (8/1/25)

AN ACT

2 To provide relative to state highways; to designate a portion of US Route 61 in East Baton Rouge Parish as the "Jackson, Gerald, Garafola, Tullier Memorial Highway"; to 3 designate a portion of Interstate 10 in St. Tammany Parish as the "Sgt. Grant Candies 4 5 Memorial Highway"; to provide for restrictions on costs of materials to the 6 department; and to provide for related matters. 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1.(A) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the 9 portion of Airline Highway, beginning in front of the property located at 9607 Airline 10 Highway and ending in front of the property located at 9000 Airline Highway, all of 11 which is located in East Baton Rouge Parish, is hereby designated as the "Jackson, Gerald, Garafola, Tullier Memorial Highway". 12 13 (B) The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed to 14 erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided local or private 15 monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for 16 material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the

sum of five hundred fifty dollars per sign.

1 Section 2.(A) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the 2 portion of Interstate 10 in St. Tammany Parish, that extends from the Oak Harbor 3 Boulevard overpass to the I-10 Twin Span Bridge, also known as the Frank Davis 4 "Naturally N'Awlins" Memorial Bridge, is hereby designated as the "Sgt. Grant 5 Candies Memorial Highway". (B) The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed to 6 7 erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided local or private 8 monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for 9 material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed the 10 sum of one thousand six hundred eighty dollars per sign.

Designates a portion of US Route 61 also known as Airline Highway in East Baton Rouge Parish as the "Jackson, Gerald, Garafola, Tullier Memorial Highway".

Designates a portion of Interstate 10 in St. Tammany Parish, that extends from the Oak Harbor Boulevard overpass to the I-10 Twin Span Bridge, also known as the Frank Davis "Naturally N'Awlins" Memorial Bridge as the "Sgt. Grant Candies Memorial Highway".

Directs DOTD to erect and maintain appropriate signs of this designation provided certain cost restrictions are satisfied.
