EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

LDR reports estimated implementation costs of approximately \$52,750 for system programming, testing, and development associated with administering the exemption, which will be absorbed within the agency's existing budget. Local taxing authorities may also incur minor administrative costs to update collection systems and confirm exempt status for eligible entities.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Miles Perret Cancer Services reports state sales tax paid in 2024 was under \$10,000 in state sales tax paid in 2024 and, should spending by the entity stay relatively stable throughout the fiscal note horizon, this would be the expected annual reduction in state general fund due to the bill. Though no data was provided on local tax payments, the LFO believes the reduction in local sales tax revenue to be roughly the same (-\$10,000) with the actual amount varying depending on the sales tax policy in the jurisdictions where purchases occur.
