## HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Substitute for Original House Bill No. 631 by Representative Bayham as proposed by the House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works

This document reflects the content of a substitute bill but is not in a bill form; page numbers in this document DO NOT correspond to page numbers in the substitute bill itself.

To enact R.S. 32:413(F), relative to the fee associated with updating the name on a driver's license; to provide applicants not eligible for driver's license renewal an exemption from duplicate fees solely for updating a name; to require a handling fee; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 32:413(F) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§413. Loss or destruction of licenses; duplicate driver's license

\* \* \*

F. An applicant who updates his name on a driver's license prior to the license becoming eligible for renewal shall be exempt from the fee imposed pursuant to the provisions of this Section and shall be required to pay only the handling fee provided for in R.S. 32:412.1(B)(1)(c).

**Abstract:** Reduces the fee applicable to updating a name on a driver's license to a handling fee as provided for in <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> requires the office of motor vehicles collect, in addition to any fee authorized by law, a handling charge of \$12 for each Class "D" and "E" driver's license transactions.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that an applicant who updates his name on a driver's license prior to the license becoming eligible for renewal be exempt from the fee imposed pursuant to the <u>present law</u> and only be required to pay the handling fee.
