COMMENDATIONS. Congratulates and commends Camille Cronin on being selected and serving Louisiana State University as 2024 Homecoming Queen.

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend and congratulate Camille Cronin for being elected the 2024 Louisiana State
3 University Homecoming Queen and to recognize her exemplary leadership,
4 academic achievements, and contributions to the LSU community.

5 WHEREAS, Camille Cronin, a proud resident of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, is
6 recognized for her outstanding character and campus leadership by her election as the 2024
7 Louisiana State University (LSU) Homecoming Queen; and

8 WHEREAS, LSU has elected one homecoming queen annually since 1933 and
9 Camille is the 91st young lady to be so recognized with this high honor; and

10 WHEREAS, Camille was selected for this honor from a field of six highly qualified
11 candidates, demonstrating the high esteem in which she is held by the LSU student body;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, a 2021 graduate of St. Joseph's Academy in Baton Rouge, Camille was
14 recognized as an AP Scholar of Distinction, an honor awarded to students who earn an
15 average score of at least 3.5 on all Advanced Placement (AP) exams taken, and scores of 3
16 or higher on five or more of these exams, showcasing her academic excellence and
17 dedication prior to entering college; and

18 WHEREAS, Camille is an active and devoted member of Phi Mu Fraternity, through

1 which she has exemplified the values of leadership, service, and sisterhood, and has served
2 as Phi Mu's Junior and New Member Delegate to the LSU Panhellenic Council, as well as
3 the chapter's first Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Chairwoman; and

4 WHEREAS, in recognition of her exceptional service to both campus and
5 community, Camille was named an Honorable Mention for Outstanding Collegiate Member
6 for Campus/Community Service by the Phi Mu National Fraternity, a prestigious
7 acknowledgment of her dedication and impact; and

8 WHEREAS, Camille's leadership began early in her college career, as she served as
9 a member and mentor for the LSU Freshman Leadership Council, a selective program that
10 fosters emerging student leaders; and

11 WHEREAS, she currently serves as the Chief Justice of the LSU Student
12 Government, having previously served with distinction as the Deputy Chief Justice, where
13 she has worked tirelessly to uphold student rights and promote a fair and just campus
14 community; and

15 WHEREAS, Camille has further demonstrated her dedication to public service
16 through her role as a Head Page for the Louisiana Senate, providing support to the legislative
17 process and gaining firsthand experience in state governance; and

18 WHEREAS, Camille will graduate in May of 2025 with a bachelor's degree in
19 political science, with a concentration in American government and politics and a minor in
20 history, reflecting her strong academic focus and commitment to civic understanding; and

21 WHEREAS, in 2024, Camille was awarded a scholarship from the Kappa Sigma
22 Fraternity's Star and Crescent Foundation, recognizing her academic merit and leadership
23 qualities, and further underscoring her positive impact within the LSU community; and

24 WHEREAS, her selection as LSU Homecoming Queen is not only a recognition of
25 her personal accomplishments, but also a reflection of her commitment to embodying the
26 spirit and traditions of Louisiana State University.

27 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
28 does hereby commend Camille Cronin for her election as the 2024 LSU Homecoming Queen
29 and extends congratulations and best wishes for continued success in her academic and
30 professional pursuits.
