A RESOLUTION

To commend and congratulate Camille Cronin for being elected as the 2024 Louisiana State University Homecoming Queen and to recognize her exemplary leadership, academic achievements, and contributions to the LSU community.

WHEREAS, Camille Cronin, a proud resident of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, is recognized for her outstanding character and campus leadership by her election as the 2024 Louisiana State University (LSU) Homecoming Queen; and

WHEREAS, LSU has elected one homecoming queen annually since 1933 and Camille is the 91st young lady to be so recognized with this high honor; and

WHEREAS, Camille was selected for this honor from a field of six highly qualified candidates, demonstrating the high esteem in which she is held by the LSU student body; and

WHEREAS, a 2021 graduate of St. Joseph's Academy in Baton Rouge, Camille was recognized as an AP Scholar of Distinction, an honor awarded to students who earn an average score of at least 3.5 on all Advanced Placement (AP) exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams, showcasing her academic excellence and dedication prior to entering college; and

WHEREAS, Camille is an active and devoted member of Phi Mu Fraternity, through which she has exemplified the values of leadership, service, and sisterhood, and has served as Phi Mu's Junior and New Member Delegate to the LSU Panhellenic Council, as well as the chapter's first Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Chairwoman; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of her exceptional service to both campus and community, Camille was named an Honorable Mention for Outstanding Collegiate Member for Campus/Community Service by the Phi Mu National Fraternity, a prestigious acknowledgment of her dedication and impact; and

WHEREAS, Camille's leadership began early in her college career, as she served as a member and mentor for the LSU Freshman Leadership Council, a selective program that fosters emerging student leaders; and

WHEREAS, she currently serves as the Chief Justice of the LSU Student Government, having previously served with distinction as the Deputy Chief Justice, where she has worked tirelessly to uphold student rights and promote a fair and just campus community; and

WHEREAS, Camille has further demonstrated her dedication to public service through her role as a Head Page for the Louisiana Senate, providing support to the legislative process and gaining firsthand experience in state governance; and

WHEREAS, Camille will graduate in May of 2025 with a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science, with a concentration in American government and politics and a minor in history, reflecting her strong academic focus and commitment to civic understanding; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, Camille was awarded a scholarship from the Kappa Sigma Fraternity's Star and Crescent Foundation, recognizing her academic merit and leadership qualities, and further underscoring her positive impact within the LSU community; and

WHEREAS, her selection as LSU Homecoming Queen is not only a recognition of her personal accomplishments, but also a reflection of her commitment to embodying the spirit and traditions of Louisiana State University.
